ZEISLOFF
LOG HOUSE

The George Zeisloff log house, built in the 1740's, was originally located along Zeisloff Road about a mile west of New Tripoli. It was moved to Ontelaunee Park in 2001. In the preservation process, we have tried to restore this house as closely as possible to the original structure. Features include the gunsight/peep hole, "Salen Fenster" (soul window), hand split cedar shakes on the roof and a 1747 five plate replica cast iron stove.



FORT
EVERETT

After leaving the scene in the 1750's after the French and Indian War, approximately 248 years later it has returned to be enjoyed as a reminder to the pioneers who settled our country. Although we don't have sketches or picture of the original Fort, we feel this reconstruction represents a very close replica of what would have existed years ago.
